Art Exhibition: *Double Take: Art and Literature Together*

Livermore Arts presents an exhibition called ***DOUBLE TAKE: Art and Literature Together*** at the Bankhead Theater Gallery Nov 3, 2021 – Jan 9, 2022. This exhibit will be in-person, with Covid-19 safety protocols in place.

Partnering with Cynthia Patton, Livermore Poet Laureate, Livermore Arts brings a pairing of art and literature to Livermore. We are seeking artwork that sings to the heart, evokes a flair for the dramatic, waxes lyric, or offers a rhythmic cadence. (Or you just think the idea is cool.) Ms Patton will be gathering literary submissions and together, the magic will happen.

A poet yourself? Send along your entry of poetry and art together. The poem can be embedded in the work or it can be framed separately from the art.

Deadline to submit work: Oct 16, 2021. Participants are invited to submit works on canvas, wood panel, metal, paper or similar substrate in any 2- or 3-dimensional medium that is suitable for hanging. All media are accepted: oil, acrylic, colored pencil, drawing, mixed media, photography, etc. In addition, there is a limited space available for sculptures.

This exhibit is produced by the Bothwell Arts Center and Livermore Arts.

- Deadline to submit images of artwork for exhibition is October 16, 2021
- Delivery dates: Tuesday, Nov 2 between 10am-12noon
- Exhibit Dates: Nov 3 – January 9, 2022
- Gallery is currently open to ticketed patrons and by appointment
- Reception Sat Nov 6, 1:30-4:30pm – free and open to the public
- Pick up artwork, Tuesday, January 11, 2022

Entry Fee:

Please submit entries electronically. Upload to 3 electronic images to agiancola@lvpac.org by **Oct 16, 6 pm. Include your name, titles of pieces, and price for sale (NFS is acceptable)**. We will accept up to three works. No nudes, overtly religious or controversial pieces will be accepted. The jurors will be part of LivermoreArts. Submit images as separate 300 dpi jpg attachments, size not to exceed 1920 x 1920 pixels. Title the jpg image files in the following format: LastnameFirstname_Title_Medium_price (ie. DoeJohn_kimono_silk_200). Subject line to read: Double Take

\$25 entry total for up to 3 images; \$10 entry fee for students. Once entry is submitted, fees are non-refundable regardless of acceptance into the exhibition.

Hanging instructions

Work must be wired and ready to hang by a wires/hanging system and/or nails. We prefer “D” hooks, but not mandatory. A label should be attached to the back of each artwork listing your name, the title of the work, price, and medium.

Upon delivery, artists will be required to sign the release form attached, giving LVPAC the right to exhibit their work and waiving liability in the event of damage or theft. Please print, sign and return to Anne Giancola at agiancola@lvpac.org

If you are **shipping** accepted artwork, it must be received by Nov 1, 2021. Ship artwork carefully, in a box, with padding. We will return it to you in the same box, only if there is return postage by label or bill of lading from UPS, Fedex, or USPS. LVPAC will not be held responsible for theft of art nor damage during shipping to and from the gallery. Ship to LVPAC, 2400 First St., Livermore, CA 94550. Any work that is not picked up within 1 week or is not prepared for return shipping will become the property of LVPAC.

LVPAC does not provide insurance for work that is damaged or stolen.

Details

All work must remain up for the duration of the show. LVPAC will handle all sales and send payment to the artists. If your artwork sells, 70% will go to you, and 30% to the gallery. LVPAC requires artists to complete a W-9 for sales in excess of \$600. The artist is responsible for paying all sales tax. The Gallery does not add sales tax to price, so please price accordingly.

LVPAC will make every effort to promote the exhibition through invitations and other forms of publicity. Email images of the show announcement and printed postcards will be available for distribution to artist’s personal contacts.
