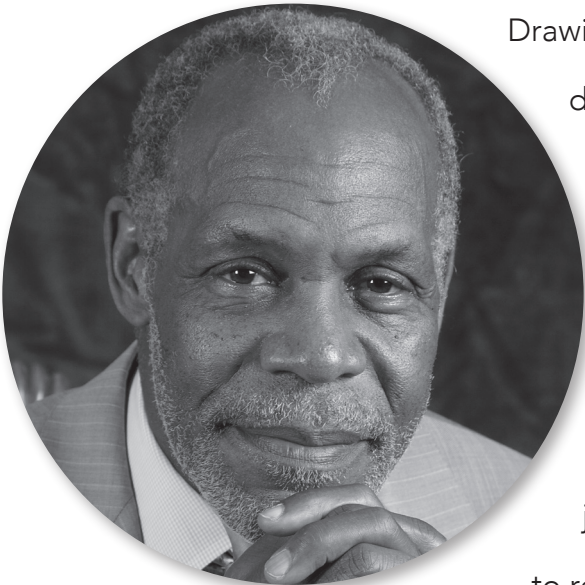


# AN EVENING WITH
