Mike Montemerlo is a Staff Software Engineer at Google working on self-driving cars. He received his B.S. and M.S. in Electrical/Computer Engineering and PhD in Robotics from Carnegie Mellon University. He worked at the Stanford Artificial Intelligence Lab as the software lead for Stanley, the robot that won the 2005 DARPA Grand Challenge. Mike will entertain you with the adventures that Google has had as he demonstrates the capabilities (and limitations) of these vehicles.
