Illuminating Symbols: from Chagall to Contemporary Symbolism

Livermore Valley Arts presents an exhibition called *Illuminating Symbols: from Chagall to Contemporary Symbolism* at the UNCLE Credit Union Art Gallery March 14 through May 19.

On display will be twelve lithographs made by artist Marc Chagall in 1964. Commissioned by the Hadassah-Hebrew Medical Center, Chagall created these works as maquettes for a series of stained glass windows to be installed in the Center's synagogue outside of Jerusalem and became well-known as the Jerusalem Windows. The UNCLE Credit Union Art Gallery is seeking submissions for works to hang in the gallery that highlight the ways in which symbols serve as bridges between the conscious and the subconscious, the familiar and the mysterious. All media and art styles are accepted and there is some limited availability for sculpture display.

- Pick up artwork, Tuesday, May 21 between 10am-noon.

Entry:

- Please submit entries electronically. Upload to 3 electronic images to agiancola@lvpac.org by **Feb 22, 2024 6 pm. Include your name, titles of pieces, size and price for sale.** We will accept up to three works. No nudes, overtly religious or controversial pieces will be accepted. The jurors will be visual arts staff of Livermore Valley Arts. Submit images as separate 300 dpi jpg attachments, size not to exceed 1920 x 1920 pixels. Title the jpg image files in the following format: LastnameFirstname_Title_Medium_size_price (ie. DoeJohn_kimono_silk_24x16_200). Subject line to read: Symbols
- \$35 entry total for up to 3 images; \$15 entry fee for students. Once entry is submitted, fees are non-refundable regardless of acceptance into the exhibition.

Hanging instructions

Work must be wired and ready to hang by a wires/hanging system and/or nails. We prefer

“D” hooks, but not mandatory. A label should be attached to the back of each artwork listing your name, the title of the work, price, and medium. Please contact gallery@lvpac.org if you have any questions on hanging.

Upon delivery, artists will be required to sign the release form attached, giving Livermore Valley Arts the right to exhibit their work and waiving liability in the event of damage or theft. Please print, sign and return to Anne Giancola at gallery@lvpac.org

Livermore Valley Arts does not provide insurance for work that is damaged or stolen.

Details

All work must remain up for the duration of the show. Livermore Valley Arts will handle all sales and send payment to the artists.

If your artwork sells, 70% will go to the artist, and 30% to the gallery. Livermore Valley Arts requires artists to complete a W-9 in order to complete payment to the artist. The artist is responsible for paying all sales tax. The Gallery does not add sales tax to price, so please price accordingly. You will receive payment up to 30 days after close of the show.

Livermore Valley Arts will make every effort to promote the exhibition through invitations and other forms of publicity. Email images of the show announcement and printed postcards will be available for distribution to artist’s personal contacts.
