

PROSPECTUS OFF THE WALL

Livermore Valley Arts presents an exhibition called *OFF THE WALL* at the UNCLE Credit Union Art Gallery Founders Room October 10 through January 5, 2025.

A call for art for SMALL WORKS to be displayed in the Founders Room and will be available for purchase and can be taken by the purchaser at the time of the sale. We are seeking works of any theme, that are 11 x 14 (including the frame, if any) and smaller. All works must be for sale. Participants are invited to submit works on canvas, wood panel, metal, paper or similar substrate in any 2- or 3-dimensional medium that is suitable for hanging. All media are accepted: oil, acrylic, colored pencil, drawing, mixed media, photography, etc. In addition, we accept jewelry if it is displayed in such a way to hang on the wall and is smaller than 11x14".

- Notice of acceptance of work will be by the end of the day, Oct 4.
- Delivery dates of accepted work: Tuesday, October 8, 10am-12noon to the UNCLE Credit Union Art Gallery at the Bankhead Theater, 2400 First Street, Livermore.
- Exhibit Dates: October 10 through January 5, 2025
- Gallery is currently open free to the public Thursday-Sundays 1-5 pm and to ticketed patrons during performances.
- The Opening Reception is Sat Nov 2, from 1-3 pm
- Pick up artwork, Tuesday, January 7, 2025

Entry:

- Please submit entries electronically. Upload to 3 electronic images to agiancola@lvpac.org by Fri Sept 27, 6pm. Include your name, titles of pieces, size and price for sale. We will accept up to three works. No overtly religious or controversial pieces will be accepted. The jurors will be visual arts staff of Livermore Valley Arts. Submit images as separate 300 dpi jpg attachments, size not to exceed 1920 x 1920 pixels. Title the jpg image files in the following format: LastnameFirstname_Title_Medium_size_price (ie. DoeJohn_kimono_silk_24x16_200). Subject line to read: Off the Wall
- \$35 entry total for up to 3 images. Once entry is submitted, fees are non-refundable regardless of acceptance into the exhibition.

Hanging instructions

Work must be wired and ready to hang by a wires/hanging system and/or nails. We prefer "D" hooks, but not mandatory. A label should be attached to the back of each artwork listing your name, the title of the work, price, and medium. Please contact gallery@lvpac.org if you have any questions on hanging.

Upon delivery, artists will be required to sign the release form attached, giving Livermore Valley Arts the right to exhibit their work and waiving liability in the event of damage or theft. Please print, sign and return to Anne Giancola at gallery@lvpac.org

Livermore Valley Arts does not provide insurance for work that is damaged or stolen.

Details

Livermore Valley Arts will handle all sales and send payment to the artists. If your artwork sells, there will be a 4% credit card processing fee and then 70% will go to the artist, and 30% to the gallery. Livermore Valley Arts requires artists to complete a W-9 in order to complete payment to the artist. The artist is responsible for paying all sales tax. The Gallery does not add sales tax to price, so please price accordingly. You will receive payment up to 30 days after close of the show.

Livermore Valley Arts will make every effort to promote the exhibition through invitations and other forms of publicity. Email images of the show announcement and printed postcards will be available for distribution to artist's personal contacts.
