### ***ADORNED: A CELEBRATION OF WEARABLE ART***

Livermore Valley Arts presents an exhibition called ***ADORNED*** at the UNCLE Credit Union Art Gallery at the Bankhead Theater in the Founders Room January 9 through January 5 – March 1, 2025.

***Adorned*** is a captivating art exhibit that explores the intersection of fashion and fine art through wearable art pieces. Each creation in the collection seamlessly blends aesthetic beauty with functional design, showcasing intricate craftsmanship that transforms everyday garments into stunning, display-worthy masterpieces. These wearable artworks, designed to be both worn and hung on a wall, challenge traditional boundaries and invite viewers to appreciate the fluidity and versatility of art. The exhibit highlights the innovative use of materials, textures, and forms, emphasizing the unique narrative each piece tells while adorning both the body and the gallery space.

The Closing Reception will be a Runway Walk when the wearable art comes off the wall and can be worn by the artist or designated model down the runway in the lobby.

- Exhibit Dates: Jan 9 through March 1, 2025
- Gallery is currently open free to the public Thursday-Sundays 1-5 pm and to ticketed patrons during performances.
- The Reception is a **Runway Walk as a Closing Reception** on Sat March 1 from 1-4 pm
- Pick up artwork, Tuesday, March 4, 2025

### **Entry:**

- Please submit entries electronically. Upload to 3 electronic images to [agiancola@lvpac.org](mailto:agiancola@lvpac.org) by Fri Dec 13, 6pm. **Include your name, titles of pieces, size and price for sale or NFS.** We will accept up to three works. No overtly religious or controversial pieces will be accepted. The jurors will be visual arts staff of Livermore Valley Arts. Submit images as separate 300 dpi jpg attachments, size not to exceed 1920 x 1920 pixels. Title the jpg image files in the following format: LastnameFirstname\_Title\_Medium\_size\_price (ie. DoeJohn\_kimono\_silk\_24x16\_200). Subject line to read: Adorned
- \$35 entry total for up to 3 images. Once entry is submitted, fees are non-refundable regardless of acceptance into the exhibition.

### **Hanging instructions**

Work must be wired and ready to hang by a wires/hanging system and/or nails. We prefer “D” hooks, but not mandatory. A label should be attached to the back of each artwork listing your name, the title of the work, price, and medium. Please contact [gallery@lvpac.org](mailto:gallery@lvpac.org) if you have any questions on hanging.

Upon delivery, artists will be required to sign the release form attached, giving Livermore Valley Arts the right to exhibit their work and waiving liability in the event of damage or theft. Please print, sign and return to Anne Giancola at [gallery@lvpac.org](mailto:gallery@lvpac.org)

Livermore Valley Arts does not provide insurance for work that is damaged or stolen.

### **Details**

Livermore Valley Arts will handle all sales and send payment to the artists.

**If your artwork sells, there will be a 4% credit card processing fee and then 70% will go to the artist, and 30% to the gallery.** Livermore Valley Arts requires artists to complete a W-9 in order to complete payment to the artist. The artist is responsible for paying all sales tax. The Gallery does not add sales tax to price, so please price accordingly. You will receive payment up to 30 days after close of the show.

Livermore Valley Arts will make every effort to promote the exhibition through invitations and other forms of publicity. Email images of the show announcement and printed postcards will be available for distribution to artist’s personal contacts.
